The MS14-P is a high performance Linux, WiFi appliance. It lets you embed Linux into your IoT/VOIP projects.

MS14-P is a low cost, open hardware Linux adapter for micro-controllers.

MS14-P runs open source linux system, has USB host port and has full Ethernet and 802.11 b/g/n WiFi capabilities.
